Synodality

Pope Francis has launched a synodal process that will take place between October 2021 and October 2023. It is a "dynamism of mutual listening, conducted at all levels of the Church, involving the whole people of God." The first level of consultation involves each of us. The "sensus fidei" (sense of faith) qualifies each of us to take part in discerning the path forward for the Church. For more information about the process check out the <u>Vatican documents</u>.
