Synod Conversations



We have been talking for a while now about the Synod that was initiated by Pope Francis last October. Now it is your turn to have your voices heard! SASMAD/PHC will be hosting two sessions, one in English and one in French to gather the reflections of volunteers on the Synod questions. You are invited to participate on either Thursday, April 7 (in French) or Friday, April 8 (in English). You can register here.

Are you curious about what a synod is all about? It is a consultation of the people of God, a "walking together" to see where the Holy Spirit is moving in the hearts of the faithful and in the Church. Come and add your voice to the conversation. Feedback from our session will be considered as part of the diocesan report and this report will be part of the feedback that the Canadian Bishops will bring to Rome. Your voice is important.

Pope Francis noted that it is especially important to hear the voices of those who may be on the margins, those that we may need to put more effort into connecting with. With this in mind, we have adapted the Synodal questions for you, as volunteers, to consult with those you visit and to receive their responses for inclusion in this Synod process. Whether they are practicing Catholics, non-Catholic or non-religious, their wisdom is important.
