The Synod: Walking Together

As the Roman Catholic Church begins the historic meetings of the Synod in Rome, we are called to reflect on what it means to be Church, what it means to walk together, to listen deeply. In our ministry of visiting those who are sick, those who are often marginalized because of illness, physical, psychological, and spiritual, we can make a difference. We can go to the margins, in places where we may not be comfortable, to bring Christ's love, compassion and light. The renewal of the church are acts such as these. At the Pre-Synodal retreat, Fr. Timothy Radcliffe O.P. says: "Renewing the Church, then, is like making bread. One gathers the edges of the dough into the centre, and spreads the centre into the margins, filling it all with oxygen. One makes the loaf by overthrowing the distinction between the edges and the centre, making God's loaf, whose centre is everywhere and whose circumference is nowhere, finding us."
